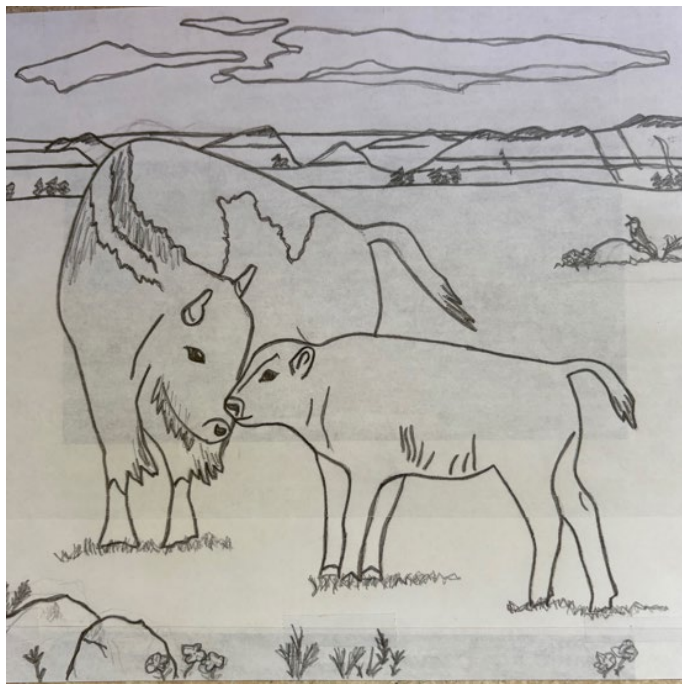

Landscape Relief with Sue Lemm



The Flickertail Woodcarvers are proud to bring featured carver Sue Lemm to guide us through a relief carving of a local landscape, tailored just for us!

The design will be your choice of a bison cow and calf in a Badlands landscape (pictured left), or a meadowlark in an appropriate setting (design TBD.)

We will be carving in bark-on basswood boards with a carvable area of 10"x10".

Class will be full days Thursday and Friday Oct 8 & 9, and the mornings of Saturday and Sunday Oct 10 & 11. All class days will be held at the Eagles Club.

Class begins at 9 AM.

Recommended tools:

- #3 gouges (or close to that) ranging in width from 5mm up to about an inch.
- Small V-tool (for outlining and texturing)
- #9 gouges (or close to that) either micro-tool size or up to about 10 mm in width (for texturing and shaping).

- Favorite bench knife
- Strongly recommended: a bench hook or clampable carving station, or at the very least, some non-slip matting to hold the board in place as you carve.
- Pencil, eraser, and the standard safety protections. Optionally, task lighting.
- Optional wood burner—for use only at the end of the project. The club will have at least one set up for class use.

The club does have sets of small-width long-handled tools that can be checked out with advance notice. Please note on the registration if long handle tools are required or email Eric.

Class Fee of \$140.00 Minimum Class size of 8 maximum class size 12.

Class participants will learn how to make their own Pysanky Egg. These eggs will become a treasured heirloom for your family.

Class will be Saturday morning and Sunday morning, Oct 10 & 11, from 9 AM to 12 PM.

Minimum Class size of 6 maximum class size 15.
